Thanks to a generous grant from the Co-op, we've also been able to enhance the outdoor area for our youngest children, creating an even more stimulating and enjoyable environment for our babies to explore and grow.

We've loved welcoming Reverend Nicki Farr to the playschool regularly – her engaging stories and delightful props always bring joy and spark imagination among the children.

This September, we'll be proudly waving off a small group of children as they take their next steps into primary school. Families have chosen a variety of wonderful schools, including Delabole, St Teath, Camelford, and St Minver.
