2	To receive apologies for absence. Apologies were received from Cllrs. R Lyle, A Stacey, G Ellis, D French.				
3	Parish Council Report for Chairiman, Cllr T Kingdon. The Chairman welcomed everyone to the meeting and tabled her report that she would also publish in the parish magazines. Copy attached to the minutes.				
4	Cornwall Council Report from Cllr Dominic Fairman. Cllr Fairman spoke about matters within Cornwall Council and his role as a Councillor that was now half way through the four year term. Cllr Adam Paynter had just completed two years as Leader of the Council; a role to be taken on by Cllr Julian German. Success had been achieved in Cornwall obtaining accreditation for the living wage with no member of staff working for less than £9.00 per hour. Cornwall Council are the only Council in the country to sign up for the Ethnical Care Charter, that pays carers travelling time and parking fees along with permits for carers and district nurses. Cllr Fairman reported on the increased use of bus services, the road networks and schemes for a link road from the A30 to the A390 at St Austell being planned, and improvements on the A30 between Carland Cross and Chiverton Cross. Cllr Fairman was also pursuing plans for a Camelford by-pass. In 2017/2018 affordable housing schemes had delivered a total of 919 homes. The thirty libraries in the county remained open with some being taken on by town
