PROPOSED WILDLIFE AREA IN DELABOLE PLAYING FIELDS

We have put together a plan, (see photo) along with feed back from the St Piran's Preschool group, for a wildlife area below the planned new Skate Park.

We have included the already existing trees, which we would like to have bird feeders etc hanging from, as well as some nesting boxes for the wild birds. We would also like to include some Hedgehog homes, wooden log piles & bug houses made from pallets, The garden areas will be planted with flowering shrubs & grasses as well as butterfly loving Budlias & large shrubs to the back of the gardens close to the hedge. We intend to plant the area with wild flowers to encourage the pollinating butterflys, bees & insects. A pathway using rubber matting wide enough for pushchairs & wheelchair access will be laid connecting the flowerbeds together. Bark chippings applied to the soil in between the shrubs & plants. With a logs roll edging to the beds.

We would like to place some sort of seating in the area, as shown in the photo, for the public to sit & admire the gardens. We are hoping to put out a request on the local Facebook page for donations of plants, shrubs & bulbs. The bulbs can be planted by the preschool children, nest boxed decorated by them, the bug hotels will have input from the preschool also.

We hope the Parish Council are in agreement with us doing this project as we feel it would not only benefit our younger members of our community but be a place where old & young can go to enjoy.
